The deadline for data entry will be October 15th. This will give us a month to analyze and finalize the data for a potential November launch of the hard copy.

Joel is working with WebFitters to see about online access to the data. See below for some of the options we could consider. At this point is only informational as we have no idea what cost would be.

I met with John Walczyk (CEO/Founder) and Jim Rafter (VP Sales & Customer Relations. We discussed these ideas but not all are a good fit, at this time, but still wanted to have them listed.

- Pass protected PDF on our website, not downloadable
- Separate Database connected to our website with secure connection
 - Would need to be updated manually from our GreenRope CRM
- Separate database that would be synced with GreenRope CRM so once updated changes are automatically updated on the web
- Separate Database that would be updated from our GreenRope CRM. Updated done by a ROVA person
- Separate Database that would be updated by the ROVA residents

Expand Database that would be updated by the ROVA resident and include additional information such as plays softball, plays pickle ball, like dancing and more. Then ROVA residents would be able to do a search for people that do similar activities. This would be way down the road, but it is possible.

Discussion: Because we already have a contract with someone for the website we will not utilize Webfitters for now, but will consider once our current contact is up. However, we will reach out to them to see if they can share anything we may be missing in our development of an online directory.

Question: Tim, We need the traffic counts for both gates.

Joe and Rich, I am starting to get some of the info we will need to make our case for a traffic light on University and Hawes. I have attached a Viewpoint Entries Tally sheet from Tim. Final count for April was not done yet when he sent this to me. I also got the count from Frank in the Golf shop and numbers from Jenny in Fat Willy's. In addition to those counts of people using Hawes Road in a given month we also have all the homes and businesses in the area. Just west of Viewpoint on University they are now leasing condos at Belboa Village. Located at 8232 University Dr. There are 32 ,3-Bedroom, 2.5 Bath units. On the other side of University and Hawes the city has put in a Utility Yard. Not sure what the long term plans are for it but now there are additional vehicles and trucks, see attached picture. At some point we should discuss a plan as to when we want to get everything together, who we need to be talking with and what City Departments we should contact.

If I recall correctly, Rich, you already have a lot of this info.

I am here full time now. We have a number of trips planned this summer. At some point, would everyone be up for a zoom meeting?
